ANNUAL PARISH MEETINGS: The meetings to elect Churchwardens, receive reports on parish activities and finances in 2022, and to elect PCC and Deanery representatives will be held in **St. James's Church on Sunday May 28th at 11am,** after the 9.30am service. This will be the only service in the Parish that day.

ELECTIONS AT THE APCM: The Parish should have 2 churchwardens, elected annually. We have only one at the moment. The Parish should have 3 representatives on Deanery Synod. The Synod has a 3-year term, starting in June. Members of Deanery Synod are also members of the PCC. Nomination forms for Churchwardens and Deanery Synod must be completed before the meeting. The PCC should have 12 elected members, who serve for 3 years, 1/3 retiring each year in rotation. We are seeking 5 members to be elected this year, 4 who may serve for 3 years and 1 for 1 one year.
